2020 Men's Basketball League Guidelines & Rules

GAME OPERATION

1. Game will be Two, 20-minute, running clock halves
2. The clock will only stop when there are 2 minutes left in the game & 1 minute in the first half.
3. Within the last 2 minutes the clock will stop during free throws and play stoppage.
4. The clock will run no matter what if there is a 12 point or larger lead at the two minute mark.
5. The officials have the authority to call a Delay of Game technical foul if they feel a team is intentionally delaying during substitution or free throws etc...
6. Halftime will be 3 minutes
7. Each team will have 2 Timeouts per game.
8. Substitutions can be made during any dead ball, but the clock continues to run.
9. Players coming into the game must alert one of the officials before coming onto the court.
10. Jumpball/Tie-up situations will be handled with a Possession Arrow procedure.
11. The Refs have the final say ... the court supervisors are in full support of them. If things get out of hand the supervisors will step in.
12. Captains are responsible for their team.
 - Rosters need to be set by the second week of play
 - A team can be made up of as many as 10 regular players and 4 subs.
 - Any player has to play at least 2 games before the tournament to play in the tournament.
 - A sub can be picked up at the discretion of the court supervisor and captains

13. Results will be posted on the website: www.lakehillsonline.org under the sports ministry page. We are also looking into setting up a group on Facebook for the league.
14. Also we may run a Men's League 3 on 3 the Thursday night after the finals. We will be inquiring about the interest of each guy. Again stay tuned.
15. Each team will get reversible jerseys with numbers on them.

FOULS

1. There is a limit of 5 individual fouls per player
 - Upon the 5th individual foul, that player will be done for the game
2. There is a limit of 7 team fouls each half before a team reaches the bonus.
 - Upon the 7th team foul, 1-and-1 free throws will be shot
 - Upon the 10th team foul, 2 free throws are shot
3. Technical fouls are at the discretion of the officials
 - Swearing will not be tolerated. If a player does slip and swear, the official will warn the player before giving a technical foul
 - The official reserves the right to call a technical on the first swear based on severity.
 - Fighting will not be tolerated; players will be ejected from the game and possibly the league.
 - When a technical foul is called, the procedure will be that the opposing team will shoot 1 free throw and possession of the ball.
 - It only takes 1 technical foul for the player to be ejected from the game. Based on severity, that player may be asked to leave the gym for the night or be allowed to remain in the gym but not the game.

- A player is only allowed 3 technical fouls for the season. If 3 technical fouls are called on a player, they will no longer be allowed to be with the team and will not be refunded their money for the league.
- Based on severity, a player may be ejected from the league before 3 technical fouls.
- If a player gets a technical foul in back-to-back games, they will be suspended for the next 2 games

VIOLATIONS

- Teams will have 10 seconds to cross the half-court line
- Teams will have 5 seconds to in-bound the ball
- Players on offense may only be in the lane for 3 seconds
- Players will have 10 seconds to shoot a free throw before a Delay of Game is called
- Players lined up to rebound on a free throw must wait for the ball to hit the rim before they move

If a defending player reaches across the out of bounds line to knock the ball out of the hands of an in-bounder, a Delay Of Game warning will be issued.

Travelling, Double Dribble, and Carrying the Ball, will be strictly enforced
